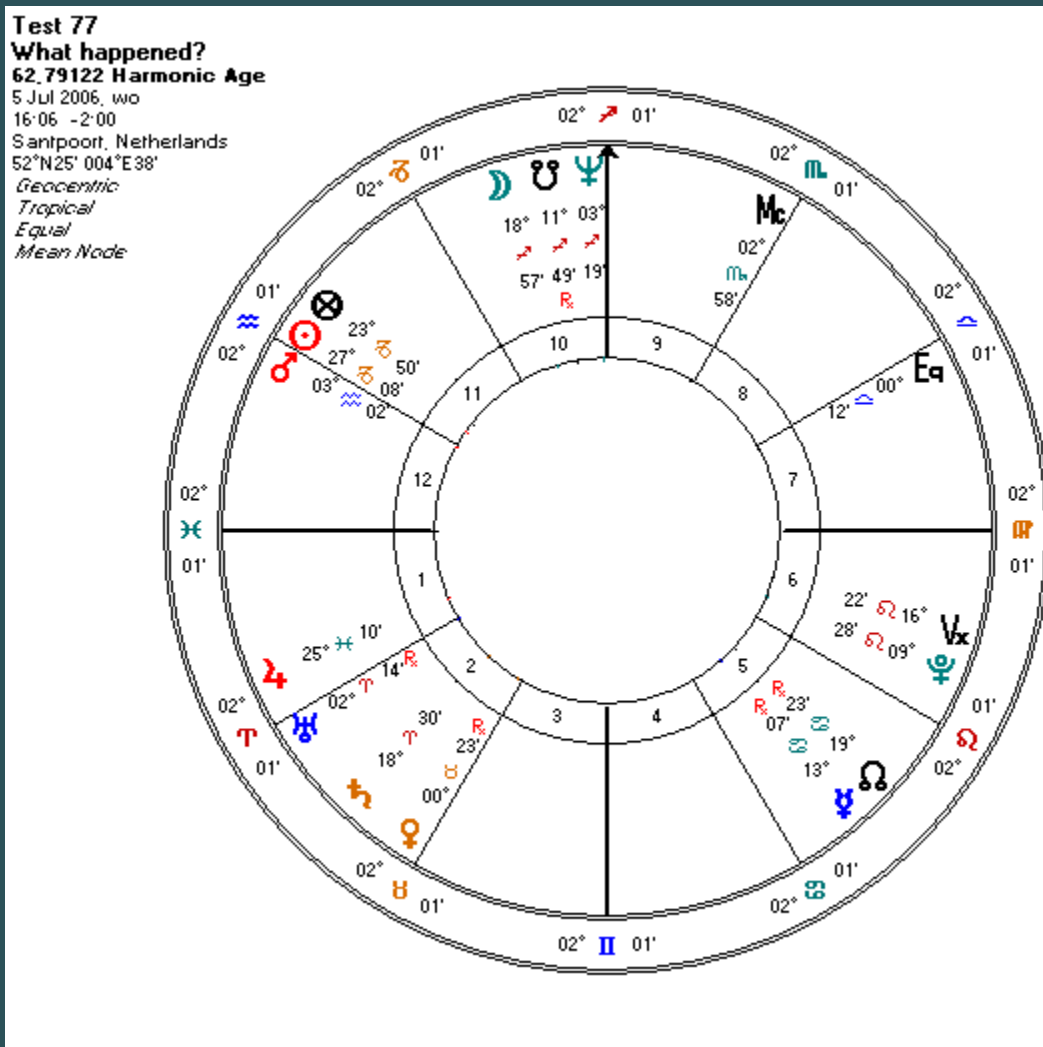


# ZODIJACK©

Astrology

The answer is option 4: she had surgery on her gallbladder.



In the AH Chart you see:

- Neptune, Ruler of the 1<sup>st</sup> sextile Mars (gall bladder) conjunct the 12<sup>th</sup> House
- Mars conjunct the 12<sup>th</sup> House cusp (of loss)
- Mars sextile Uranus, Ruler of the 12<sup>th</sup> House
- Mars square the Floating MC in Scorpio
- Eq. Ascendant conjunct the 8<sup>th</sup> House cusp (House of surgery)

10 Astrologers participated in the Test, 5 found the correct, one in a second attempt.  
Below follow their answer in order of receipt:

### **Anand Ghúryé (India)**

uses the AH Technique

Eq on 8<sup>th</sup> cusp and Mars on 12<sup>th</sup> cusp indicates she had surgery on her gallbladder.

### **Susanne Tietgens (Germany)**

uses the AH Technique

For gall I use the significators: Mars, Scorpio, Saturn and for gallbladder: Saturn, Capricorn/Cancer

- Asc Pisces = weak health. Classic Ruler Jupiter in the 1<sup>st</sup> House: Weakness or a loss that affects the person physically

Modern ruler Neptune cusp 10<sup>th</sup> House anticon Sun on cusp 12: surgery for a physical problem

- Biwheel: AH Jupiter square Saturn natal chart in the 6<sup>th</sup> House: gallstones

Biwheel: AH Sun in Capricorn inconjunct Saturn natal chart in the 6<sup>th</sup> House

This puts the focus on Saturn natal chart in 6, gallbladder

- AH Ruler from 6, the Sun, cusp 12 in Capricorn conjunct Mars: surgery

- Mars square Floating MC in Scorpio: gallbladder surgery

- Biwheel: AH Jupiter anticon Mercury natal chart (Ruler of 6<sup>th</sup>): health problems

- Natal chart ruler from the 6<sup>th</sup> House is Mercury, which is in the AH in Cancer (gallbladder)

### **Matthieu Kaiser (France)**

uses Lunar Eclips, Quotidian

The lunar eclipse of March 14, 2006 was at 24° Virgo, in the 8<sup>th</sup> House (surgery), conjunct with the natal Sun, ruler of the 8<sup>th</sup>, and square Saturn

The solar eclipse of March 26 was at 8° Aries, opposed to Mercury, Ruler of the 6<sup>th</sup> House.

Jupiter stationed retrograde on March 4 at 18° Scorpio, in square with natal Jupiter, Ruler of the 1<sup>st</sup> (the body) and the 12<sup>th</sup> (hospitals). It was triggered by a square sent by transiting Mars on July 4 (i.e. just one day before the event)

In the lunar return, Saturn, almuten of the 1<sup>st</sup> and lord of the year, is conjunct with Mars (surgery) and in exact square with Jupiter (ruler of the 6<sup>th</sup>). The Part of Infirmities is close to the Ascendant

In the quotidian chart, the Sun, almuten of the 6<sup>th</sup>, posited in the 8<sup>th</sup>, casts an exact trine to the Ascendant. Mars, ruler of the 1<sup>st</sup>, is in exact opposition with Neptune, which relates to anesthesia. It is also in square with the Part of Infirmities, which is ruled by Mars and posited in the 1<sup>st</sup> House (thus stressing the importance of the matter during this day)

### **S L Narasimhan (India)**

Method - KCIL using SSL

Dasa running on event date was Mercury-Venus-Sun-Mercury-Saturn

These Planets are not only source in houses 1,6, 8 and 12 but they are operating these Houses at stellar and Sub level. Ascendant SSL Sat involves 1,6,8,12 and commits to 6 (Gallbladder) indicate proness of native to get affected in the lower abdomen area. Moreover Mercury is ruler of 6<sup>th</sup> house in Natural Zodiac and equally malign in the chart confirms proness of lower abdomen disease to the native during Mercury period.

Real transit - Moon transits in Venus sign (bhukti lord) and in Rahu star on the given day. Rahu with positional status is SSL of 8<sup>th</sup> House. Sun transit on Mercury sign (Dasa lord) and again on Rahu star. Again slow moving planet Saturn whose transit indicates major operation /death transits on Moon sign (6<sup>th</sup> House SSL -gallbladder) and MercuryStar (Dasa lord). Jupiter which determines year of event transits on Venus sign (bhukti lord) and again on Rahu star who is 8<sup>th</sup> SSL. Thus transit agrees with event.

Virtual Transit- Progressed Ascendant SSL is again Saturn and Progressed moon position operates 1-6-8-12 in the Progressed chart doubly confirms the event.

uses the AH Technique

Pluto (surgery)in 6<sup>th</sup> House opposite Mars (gall bladder) in 12<sup>th</sup> House
