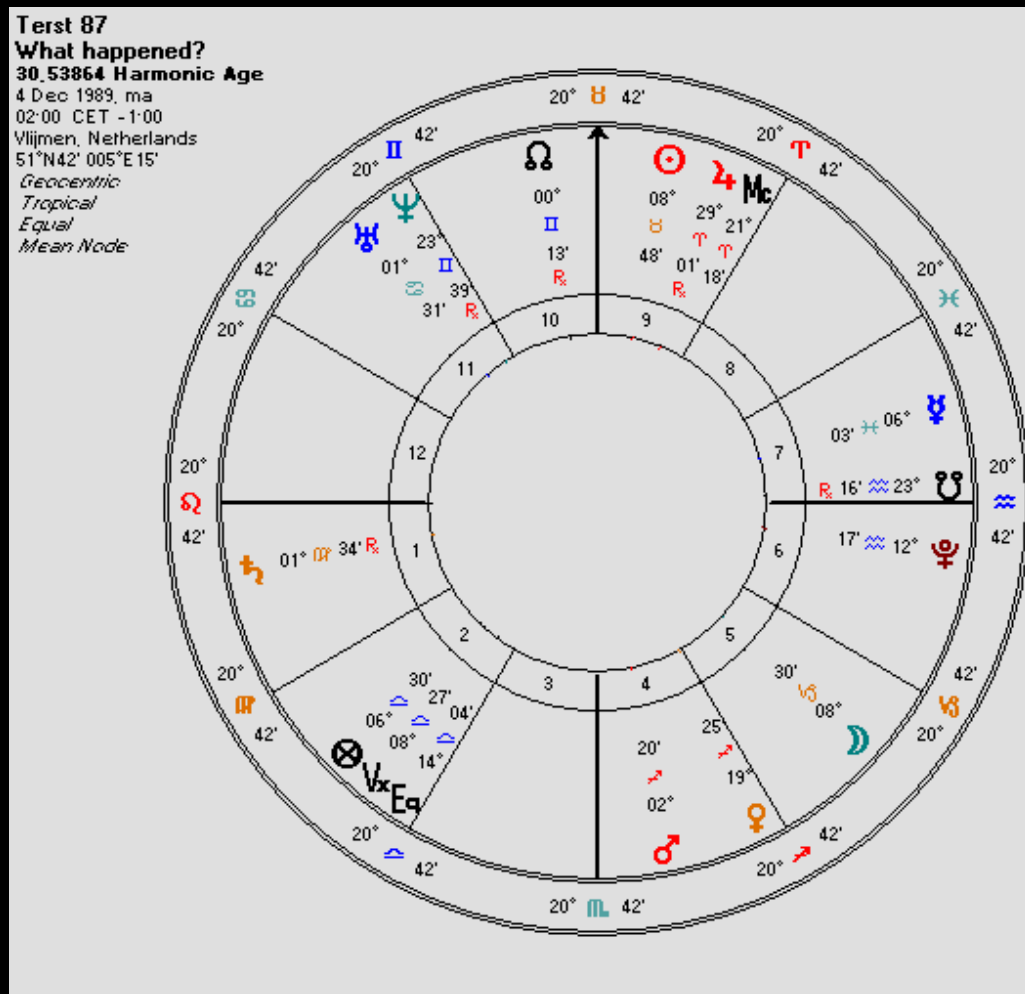

The answer to Test 87 is option 2: she gave birth to a baby girl



In the above Chart your attention is drawn to:

- the 5th House with Venus right on the cusp of that House

- Moon, Ruler of her natal 5th House, trine the Sun, Ruler of the 1st AH House trine Saturn in the 1st
- Floating Mc conjunct Jupiter the natural Ruler of children

8 Astrologers participated in the test. 5 Astrologers found the correct answer. Below follow their answer in order of receipt.

Irmgard Dering (USA)
uses the AH Technique

- Floating Mc 150° Natal Vx
- Moon H5 120° Sun, 90° Vx
- Venus conjunct cusp H5 and PoF conjunct cusp H5.

Pierre le Gal (France)
uses Vedic astrology, ayanamsa Chandra Hari

The running period for the event is the period of Mercury and a sub-period of the Sun. Mercury rules the 5th House of children and is in a nakshatra of Venus in the 5th House. Venus signifies a baby girl.

The Sun is in its own nakshatra. Therefore it is not taken into account. The Sun is in Taurus, a sign of Venus, and makes an aspect to Jupiter. Moreover the Sun rules the 5th counted from Mercury, the lord of the mahadasha.

Erika Eilert-Hetin (Germany)
uses the Solar Return

In the Solar Return
the Asc Cancer (which is the Sign on the 5th natal House),
Moon in 5th House of children
Libra cusp 5, Ruler Venus conj. Jupiter (natural significator of growth and children).
Mars and Pluto (birth) trine, Pluto sextile Saturn (Ruler of the 8th House) in opp. to Mars (birth).

Susanne Tietgens (Germany)

uses the AH Technique

- Leo Ascendant – an indication of children
- Sun trine Moon in the 5th House
- Venus in the 5th trine the Ascendant and MC pointing in the direction of a baby girl
- Jupiter (children) in antiscion to Saturn in the 1st House
- Biwheel: Venus in the 5th House in the Age Harmonic falls on the natal MC

Aurore Paquet (France)

uses the Lunar and Solar eclipses

I'll start with the eclipses:

Lunar Eclipse of August 17, 1989 at 24°12 Aquarius in the 12th house, square to Jupiter and the Moon in the 8th House, Jupiter ruling the Ascendant and the Moon ruling the 5th House of children: I deduce that she may have been hospitalized and undergone surgery during this eclipse.

Saturn at 7°48 Capricorn, dispositor of the eclipse, transits natal Saturn, in partile aspect to the natal Moon at 23°06 Scorpio (note that the Moon is in the 8th house, almuten of the 5th and 6th Houses).

The Solar Eclipse of August 31, 1989, at 7°46 Virgo in the natal 7th house, touches Saturn in the 11th house, ruler of the 11th and 12th houses. These two eclipses activate the 12th and 7th houses and, through the interplay of the rulers of the planets involved, the 5th and 6th houses.

The ruler of the year and the divider is Mercury. Natal Mercury is in Taurus, a fixed sign, receiving an applying aspect from the Moon (almuten of the 5th and 6th houses) and from Venus in the 5th house.

In the Solar Return chart, Mercury is affected by the Moon and Jupiter, signifiers of childbirth. In the Solar Return chart, Mercury in its domicile in the 11th house (a fortunate house) is applied to Venus, ruler of the 5th house, and the Solar Return Ascendant is in Cancer.

The Moon is in the 5th house of children.

In the Solar Return chart, the Part of Children is at 19°58 Aquarius. Saturn, dispositor of the Part in its domicile, is one of the almutens of the 5th House. Jupiter's retrograde motion on October 31, 1989, at 10°52 Cancer activates natal Venus. These configurations lead me to predict a pleasant year.

I would like to ask everyone to link the technical astrological findings to a practical explanation. For example, linking the 5th House to children, etc. I think this will make it more understandable for less advanced astrologers. Thank you.
